

Connection to land and country; this painting is dedicated to my pop who loved Uluru, the most beautiful place - land, country and sky - all part of a spiritual cosmos.






Family is very important and can be a big influence on children, like stars we don't always see family but they are there. On clear nights, we go outside and look up at the night sky and count the stars.





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
